

TRYING TO FIGURE OUT HOW MUCH YOU OWE? *This might help...*

\$75.00 is the family fee. It will cover everyone in your family... both parents and all children registering. The fee includes books and classroom supplies for the traditional programs and all materials for Generations of Faith. It would not cover adult Bible study materials, the One Parish, One Book Offering or the Catholicism DVD series workbooks should you choose to take one of these classes.

IMPORTANT NOTE... All children in Sacramental Preparation Programs for First Reconciliation, First Eucharist and Confirmation are required to attend Generations of Faith with their families. That automatically makes your fee the family fee.

\$55.00 is the two individual fee. This fee applies to two children registering for a traditional class only or one adult and one child during Sacramental years. The fee would include all books and materials for the class in addition to helping to defray the costs of celebrations (Christmas, final class, etc.) conducted for the children throughout the year.

\$35.00 is the individual child fee. This fee applies to any single child registering for a traditional class only. The fee would include all books and materials for the class in addition to helping to defray the costs of celebrations (Christmas, final class, etc.) conducted for the children throughout the year.

IMPORTANT NOTE... We do not ask adults to pay the \$35.00 fee for Adult Programs. Your fee would be determined by the adult classes you decide to take and paid for at the time we order materials.

\$65.00 is the fee for S.P.Y. This fee is required for all High School students participating in the Sunday evening or Sunday morning S.P.Y. programs. The fee covers all materials and food used in the program throughout the year.

\$TBD is the fee for the Year 2 Confirmation Retreat. This required retreat is in the Fall for students involved in the second year of their Confirmation preparation (typically 8th grade).

ONE NOTE ABOUT YOUR ABILITY TO PAY: If any of these fees pose a financial hardship for your family, please do not let that keep you from registering; give us the chance to arrange payments or find scholarship money for your family.
